Carol will share information about the many fairs in Wayne County, and especially the Wayne County Fair which has been in Palmyra for 150 years this year. You are encouraged to check out their website which contains some of their history in an article by Pamela Ferrant: it is found at www.waynecountyfair.org. Pamela writes: "In 1856, Floral Hall was built to host the first annual Wayne County Fair in Palmyra. People from all over the region came to show off their livestock and poultry; their quilts and fine silks; their fruits and vegetables. It was the beginning of an era. The start of a tradition."
