

An Act to divide
the town of Ontario in the
County of Wayne.

The people of the State of New York
represented in Senate and Assembly: Do enact as follows:

§ I From and after the first Monday of April next all that part of the town of Ontario in the County of Wayne lying South of a line beginning at the southwest corner of lot number one hundred and seventy in township number thirteen in the third range of townships, and running from thence Easterly along the south line of lots number, one hundred and seventy one, one hundred and seventy two, one hundred and seventy three, one hundred and seventy four, seventy nine, twenty eight and seventy seven to the East line thereof and from thence South along the west line of lot number, seventy six to the southwest corner thereof, and from thence Easterly along the south line of lots numbers seventy six and seventy five to the East line of said township number thirteen shall be and remain a separate town by the name of **Walworth** and the first town meeting shall be held on the first Tuesday of April next at the house of George Smith and annually thereafter as shall be agreed upon by the inhabitants at their annual town meetings.

§ II The remaining part of the town of Ontario shall remain a separate town by the name of Ontario and the next town meeting therein shall be held on the first Tuesday of April next at the now dwelling house of Ashbel Culver in said town and annually thereafter as shall be agreed upon by the inhabitants at their annual town meetings.

§ III The supervisors and overseers of the poor of the said towns shall as soon as may be after the first town meetings therein upon notice to be given by the said Supervisors or one of them meet together and apportion the poor and poor monies and other funds of the said towns agreeably to the last tax list of said town of Ontario and each town shall thereafter support and maintain its own poor.
